Barbour County Schools is seeking proposals for a comprehensive, schoolwide leadership and character development program to be implemented across multiple school sites. The purpose of this program is to foster academic achievement, social-emotional growth, and student empowerment through structured, values-based learning experiences integrated into daily instruction and school culture.

Program Requirements:

Vendors must submit a proposal that includes the following features:

- A whole-school framework focused on developing student leadership, responsibility, initiative, goal setting, and problem-solving.
- A curriculum that supports social-emotional learning (SEL) and aligns with state academic standards.
- Structured staff training and professional development, both initial and ongoing, for teachers and school leaders.
- Tools for creating a positive school climate through leadership roles, recognition systems, and student-led initiatives.
- A model that is sustainable and scalable, with resources for year-round integration into classroom and school-wide activities.
- Access to print and/or digital materials, student journals, and facilitator guides.
- Support for family and community engagement that reinforces the principles taught in schools.
- A defined implementation timeline and metrics for program evaluation and progress monitoring.

- All bids must be submitted electronically or via mail by 4:00 PM on Monday, May 20, 2025.
- Proposals should include:
 - Program overview and evidence of effectiveness
 - Training and support plan
 - Sample materials
 - Total cost, including training, materials, and support
 - References from current or former K-12 clients
