Many students, both general and special education, may have experienced some regression or loss of skills due to the COVID-19 school closures. Barbour County Schools will be offering in person extended learning opportunities through the month of June. Students in K-8 will have the opportunity to attend four days a week with their existing schedules to recover academic skills. High School students will be offered credit recovery, in addition to remediation of academic skills; to those students and parents who choose to send their child/children.
