

FACILITY DEVELOPMENT GOALS

1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 It is the goal of the Barbour County Board of Education to identify school facility needs in the county and determine ways and means of providing required facilities.

2.0 RESPONSIBILITY

- 2.1 The Barbour County Board of Education has the responsibility to provide and maintain school facilities that meet the educational needs of all students in Barbour County.
- 2.2 Meeting this need necessitates the cooperation and assistance of professional educators, administrators, architects, and general public.
- 2.3 The Barbour County Board of Education has the responsibility to adopt a Comprehensive Educational Facilities Plan (CEFP) to meet the local school facility needs. By following the CEFP and additional guidelines of the State Board Policy 6200, the Barbour County Board shall provide:
 - 2.3.1 By purchase, lease, building or otherwise, schoolhouses and other buildings to meet the educational needs of its district;
 - 2.3.2 The necessary furniture, fixtures, apparatus, fuel and all necessary supplies for the schools;
 - 2.3.3 For the health and cleanliness of the pupils through the development of facilities;
 - 2.3.4 For the repair and good order of the school grounds, buildings and equipment including preventative maintenance.
